

The Blue Foundation Scholarship, dedicated in memory of Myrtle Knight, is accepting new applications from graduating senior high school students. **Six deserving seniors will receive scholarships for \$2,000 each.**

Eligible applicants must:

- Be a member of the credit union with a Share Savings account in his/ her own name.
- Be graduating in the spring of the current school year and planning to attend college full time during the fall term.
- Use the scholarship at any accredited school of higher learning, including four-year colleges, two-year junior or community colleges, and accredited trade schools.

Winners will be notified by mail in the early part of May and announced during Blue's Annual Meeting.

- Never call the phone number that is provided to you through a suspicious email, text message, or over the phone.


